The Consumer Price Index (CPI) in January 2010 was 118.01 or inflated 0.84 % from December 2009 at 117.03. In January 2010, the changes of each expenditure group as follows: the foodstuff increased from 127.46 to 129.66 or inflated 1.73 %; the prepared food, beverages, cigarette and tobacco increased from 123.96 to 126.35 or inflated 1.93 %; the housing, water, electricity, gas and fuel increased from 115.09 to 115.48 or inflated 0.34 %; the clothing decreased from 119.01 to 118.77 or deflated 0.20 %; the health increased from 113.38 to 113.55 or inflated 0.15 %; the education, recreation and sport increased from 114.11 to 114.22 or inflated 0.10 %, and the transportation, communication and financial services increased from 103.32 to 103.49 or inflated 0.16 %.

The inflation in January 2010 was mainly caused by price increases of several commodities, i.e.: rice, cooked rice and side dishes served together, fresh fish, sugar, red

chili, cooked noodle, household fuel, cooking oil, filter cigarette, leasing house fee, passenger plane fare, tomato (vegetable), *soto*, fried chicken, porridge of rice, clove-flavored cigarette, rental house fee, preserved fish, spinach, cigarette without clove flavoring, *gado-gado*, housemaid cost, *ketupat/lontong sayur*, umbrella, tomato (fruit) car, soft drinks, fried cookies, and satay. Meanwhile, the prices of the following commodities were decreased, i.e.: orange, gold accessories, purebred chicken meat, purebred chicken eggs, small chili, shallot, apple and string bean.

In January 2010, the core of CPI changed from 115.33 to 116.01 or inflated 0.59 % (see Table 2). The administered price component changed from 113.23 to 113.73 or inflated 0.44 % and the volatile component changed from 127.99 to 130.52 or inflated 1.98 %.

The core inflation rate of calendar 2010 and year on year (January 2010 to January 2009) were 0.59 % and 4.43 % respectively. While inflation rate of the administered price component of calendar 2010 and year on year were 0.44 % and -0.18 % respectively. Furthermore inflation rate of the volatile component of calendar 2010 and year on year were 1.98 % and 5.17 %.
