The Consumer Price Index (CPI) in February 2010 was 118.36 or inflated 0.30 % from January 2010 at 118.01. In February 2010, the changes of each expenditure group as follows: the foodstuff increased from 129.66 to 130.78 or inflated 0.86 %; the prepared food, beverages, cigarette and tobacco increased from 126.35 to 126.85 or inflated 0.40 %; the housing, water, electricity, gas and fuel increased from 115.48 to 115.71 or inflated 0.20 %; the clothing decreased from 118.77 to 118.21 or deflated 0.47 %; the health increased from 113.55 to 113.76 or inflated 0.18 %; the education, recreation and sport increased from 114.22 to 114.30 or inflated 0.07 %, and the transportation, communication and financial services increased from 103.49 to 103.60 or inflated 0.11 %.

The inflation in February 2010 was mainly caused by price increases of several commodities, i.e.: rice, small chili, purebred chicken meat, tomato (vegetable), shallot,

porridge of rice, cooked rice & side dishes served together, sugar, clove-flavored cigarette, filter cigarette, leasing house fee, rental house fee, wages of labor, household fuel, housemaid cost, and motorcycle. Meanwhile, the prices of the following commodities were decreased, i.e.: gold accessories, fresh fish, purebred chicken eggs, potato, orange, cooking oil, and cellular telephone.

In February 2010, the core of CPI changed from 116.01 to 116.18 or inflated 0.15 % (see Table 2). The administered price component changed from 113.73 to 113.94 or inflated 0.18 % and the volatile component changed from 130.52 to 131.83 or inflated 1.00 %.

The core inflation rate of calendar 2010 and year on year (February 2010 to February 2009) were 0.74 % and 3.88 % respectively. While inflation rate of the administered price component of calendar 2010 and year on year were 0.63 % and 2.26 % respectively. Furthermore inflation rate of the volatile component of calendar 2010 and year on year were 3.00 % and 5.19 %.
